YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly COVID-19 Health Policy and Stay Requirements

It is the responsibility of the group leader to circulate and collect signed forms from group participants.

COVID-19 Warning & Disclaimer

COVID-19 has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly **cannot guarantee that you will not become infected with COVID-19**. Further, being a guest at YMCA Blue Ridge could increase your risk of contracting COVID-19.

Stay Requirements

The health and safety of our guests, staff and community is our number one priority. As such, starting September 15, 2021, proof of a full COVID-19 vaccination or negative COVID-19 test result are required for you and your group members to stay at YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly.

For the Vaccinated

YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly strongly encourages vaccination. The last day to receive the second shot of the Moderna or Pfizer vaccine or a single dose of Johnson & Johnson is two weeks before your check-in date.

For the Unvaccinated

For patrons who are not fully vaccinated, a negative COVID-19 test result must be obtained within 72 hours (3 days) of your check-in date.

Mask Mandate

In accordance with Buncombe County's State of Emergency mandate declared on August 18, 2021, masks will be required for all guests indoors at YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly and will also be strongly encouraged in large groups outdoors.

If YMCA Blue Ridge Assembly closes in response to Federal, State or Local orders, your group will be asked to vacate the premises immediately at your own expense.
